



Statement on Use of Cobalt and Mica

Dear Valued Silicon Labs Customer,

In an effort to eliminate the impact of our supply chain on conflict minerals, Silicon Labs has begun collecting smelter information on cobalt and mica in addition to the conflict minerals under Section 1502 of HR 4173. We are actively working with our suppliers to understand or establish their systems for sourcing of raw materials, including any cobalt or mica related minerals which may be used in Silicon Labs' products.

An RMI (Responsible Minerals Initiative) EMRT (Extended Minerals Reporting Template) form will be available upon request for customers. Silicon Labs does not use Mica in our products and requires all suppliers to source from Conflict-Free Cobalt smelters, maintain a Conflict-Free sourcing policy, and comply with our internal policy based on the OECD due diligence guidelines.

Silicon Labs is committed to a conflict-free supply chain. There are no known Conflict Minerals including Cobalt or Mica in Silicon Labs' products that directly or indirectly finance or benefit armed groups in the Democratic Republic of the Congo or adjoining countries.
